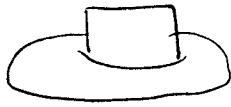
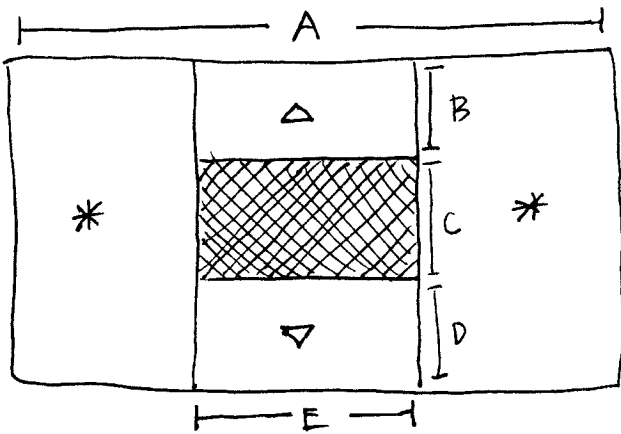


BEEKEEPERS HAT ("VEIL")

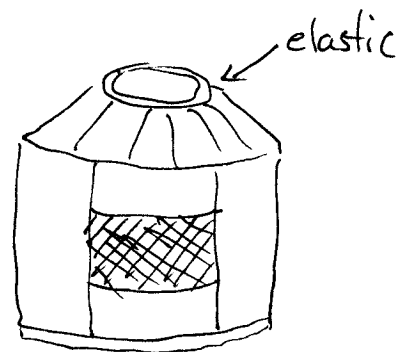
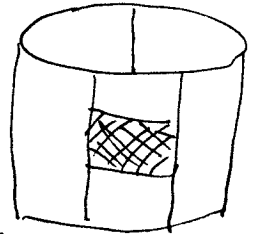


1. start with a sturdy, breathable straw hat. The brim should not be overly wide
2. measure + cut your cloth + mesh cloth can be any light colored cloth or canvas.



- A. The diameter of your hat brim, plus 3-4 inches
- B. The width of your hat brim plus 3 inches
- C. 7"
- D. 8"
- E 12"

3. sew together Δ , ∇ and mesh to make middle panel
4. sew side panels (*) to middle panel
5. sew together ends to make tube
6. fold over top + bottom edges twice and sew to make a tube approx $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide. leave a place open to feed in your string or elastic. opening should be in the back
7. feed string or elastic into the top and secure to fit tightly around brim of hat.
8. feed string into bottom tube
9. to wear, pull string tight around back pull under arms + tie around chest in front.



string - comes out from behind the head + ties in front
